**Rob Miller** – Shared that he has been a part of the request for upcoming review of maternity services, offered thanks for the progress and improvements that has been achieved to date and hopes that the review highlights the period where families were impacted and is an opportunity to celebrate UHSussex achievement to date.

**Lucy Bloem** – Thanks to Rob for sharing his thoughts openly.

**Emma Wall** – Asked about plans for continuity of care & stats.

**Gail Addison** – Shared that the community team work hard to provide antenatal continuity, it's a little trickier with postnatal. Continuity teams at PRH & RSCH, Worthing & Chichester have plans to reintroduce continuity teams. Stats – over 80% for Worthing & in the 90% at SRH.

**Nicky Greenfield** – RSCH & PRH also try to provide antenatal continuity. Currently 3 continuity teams & RSCH & PRH for low-risk women, plans in place to introduce teams for women who need extra support – ethnic minorities, those who have experienced loss & areas of depravation. Offering antenatal postnatal and intrapartum continuity.
