2.1	 Emma Chambers – Director of Midwifery UHSussex Reassured there are being more connections made with Neonates Shared how challenging the last few months have been, recruitment and retention crisis, recruitment is improving, shifts are better staffed now Working hard on CNST for Trusts submission to demonstrate that they are a safe service, able to meet the submission requirements Now meeting criteria for all birthing people to have carbon monoxide readings New pathways for scanning high risk pregnancies More investment in Trust for leadership and junior staff training Planning a site visit to Medway to view refurbishment of birthing rooms, will link in with MVP regarding how to improve birth environments Working on getting involved in national research around maternity services CQC survey results, UHSussex was higher than average in some areas, no areas were lower than average Dec/Jan homebirth suspensions due to staffing issues and ambulance strikes, as well as some birthing people being diverted, they appreciate the significance of this, but safely needs to be maintained, Becki added that this is continually reviewed Becki updated on current job adverts In response Tracey Nevell shared the above average response rate to the CQC survey and provided an update on maternity survey plans, webinar 	016
